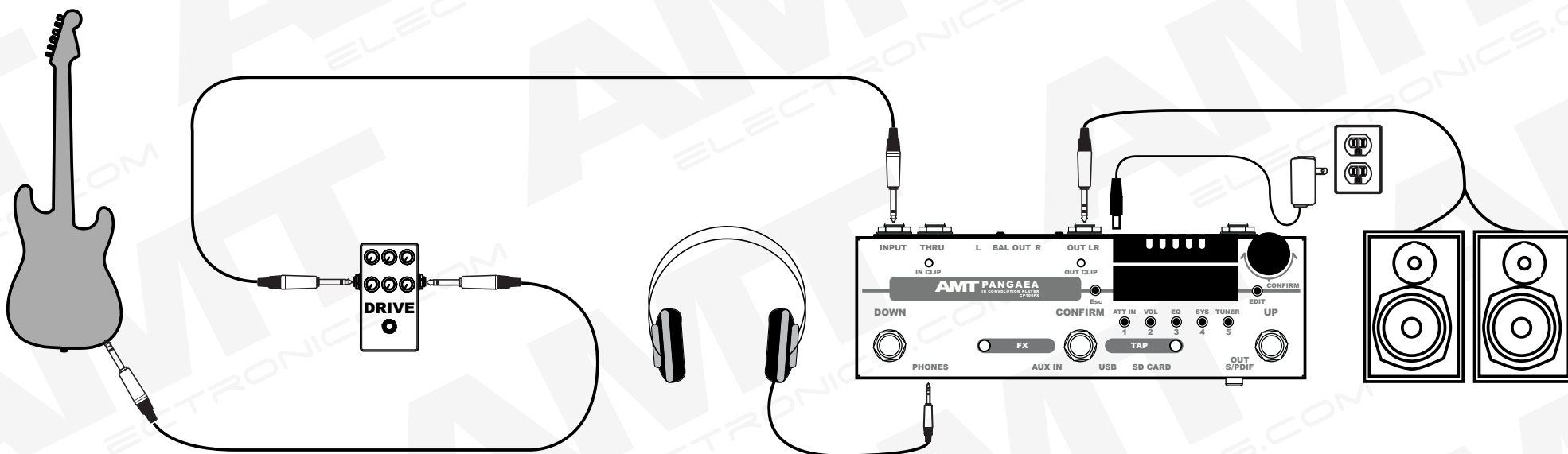
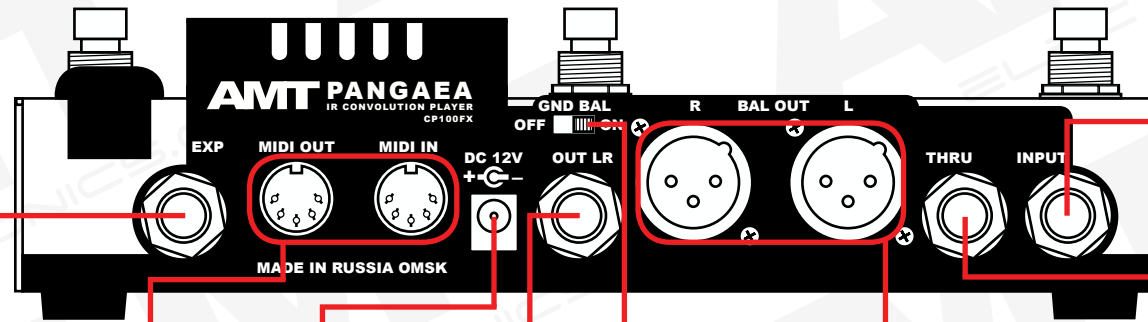


Quick Start

AMT PANGAEA
IR CONVOLUTION PLAYER
CP-100FX

1. Turn the volume knob on your guitar all the way down to zero.
2. If you want to use your effect pedals connect the last pedal's output to Pangaea's **Input**, just like you would normally connect it to a guitar amp. You can also plug your guitar directly into Pangaea! See the diagram below.
3. Use 1/4" TRS cable to connect Pangaea's **Main Out** to your playback system or simply plug your headphones into **Phones Out**.
4. Connect the included AC adapter to Pangaea and plug it into a power outlet.
5. Turn on your playback system.
6. Now slowly turn up your guitar's volume. Watch out, it may get pretty loud!
7. Too loud? Press **2/VOL** button to adjust volume. Turn **Navigation/Confirm** knob to choose between Master and Phones volume. Press it to edit the values. Press **Esc** to return to the home screen.
8. Browse pre-programmed tones using the **Navigation/Confirm** knob. Press it to recall the selected preset.
9. Press **Edit** button to edit a preset. You'll see effect blocks: **RF** (Resonance Filter); **GT** (Noise Gate); **CM** (Compressor); **PR** (Preamp Simulator); **PA** (Power Amp Simulator); **IR** (Cabinet Simulator); **EQ** (Parametric EQ); **DL** (Delay); **PH** (Phaser); **FL** (Flanger); **CH** (Chorus); **ER** (Early Reflections); **RV** (Reverb) and **TR** (Tremolo). Turn **Navigation/Confirm** knob to select the desired effect block and press it to enable/disable the effect. Press **Edit** again to tweak effect's parameters. When you're done press **Esc** several times to get back to the home screen.
10. Out of tune? Activate the tuner by pressing **5/TUNER** button.
11. While on the home screen press **Esc** to see currently chosen Impulse Response's name.

Connect a standard expression pedal, such as AMT EX-50

This output sends out an unprocessed copy of whatever comes into Pangaea's **Input**. Use a speaker cable to connect a speaker cabinet or a dummy load here in case you're feeding a signal from a tube amp or a power amp into Pangaea's **Input**!

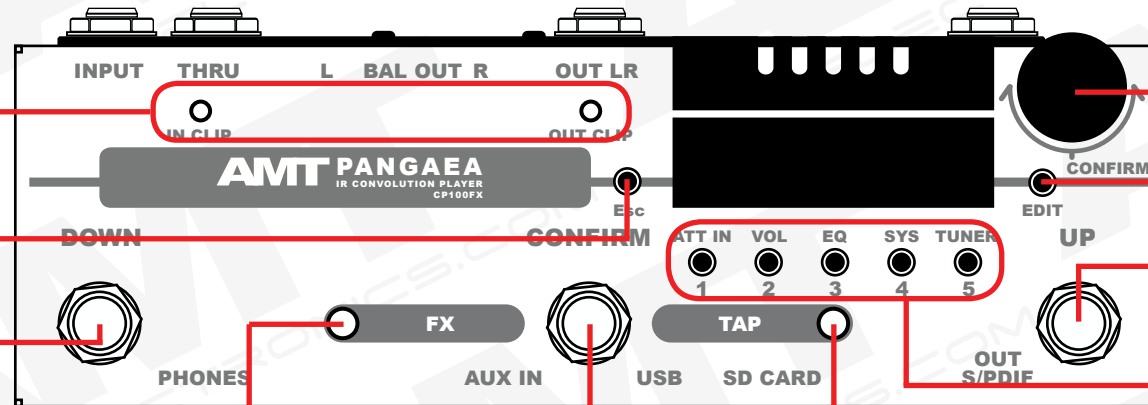
Connect to MIDI equipment

Connect the included AC adapter here

Connect to guitar amp or playback system

Turn it off to eliminate hum and buzz caused by ground loops

Use balanced XLR cables to connect to the mixer, PA or studio equipment



Lights green when the sound comes into Pangaea.
Lights orange when clipping occurs

Turn to select presets and press to recall the selected preset.
Turn to select the effect block. Press to turn the selected effect block on or off.
Turn to navigate or to choose between values. Press to enter sub-level menu/edit the selected parameter or to confirm the selected value

Press to see currently chosen cabinet's name.
Press to return to the upper level menu or to the home screen

Press to edit the preset or the effect block

Press to select presets.
Alternative function may be assigned

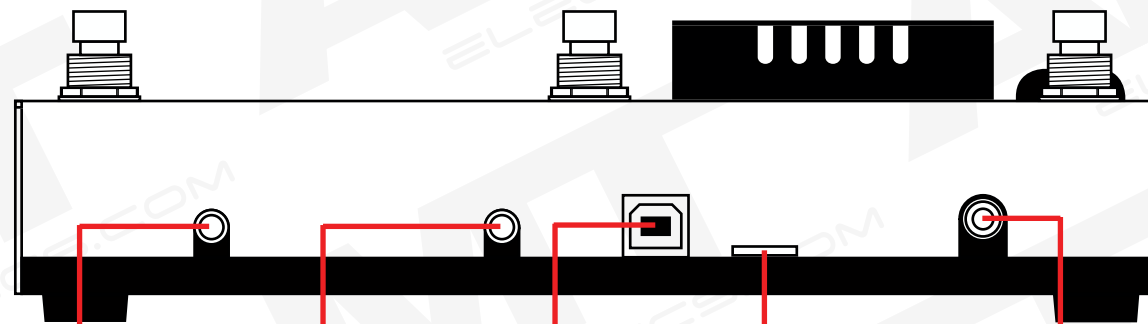
Press to select presets.

Lights when the effects are activated

Press to recall the selected preset.
Alternative function may be assigned

Shows you the time and speed of delay and modulation effects

When on the home screen press:
1/ATT IN to adjust attenuator settings
2/VOL to adjust output levels
3/EQ to access the Master EQ
4/SYS to get to the system menu
5/TUNER to activate the tuner.



When on the preset screen press:
1/ATT IN to reset the preset to factory default settings
2/VOL to adjust output level for the current preset
3/EQ to manage controllers for the current preset
4/SYS to rename the preset
5/TUNER to copy currently selected effect block to another preset

Connect headphones here

Connect external audio device, such as MP3 player

Connect to the computer and access the internal storage

Insert microSD card here and access unlimited amount of Impulse Responses

Connect to studio equipment via S/PDIF
